


## What is a "social pyramid"?

 Think about the social pyramid at your school? Who would you place at the top, middle, bottom? Think about the influential people at your school, and place them in the pyramid!




The supreme ruler over all of Egypt, wore a special crown known as the double crown (combination of white and red symbolizing the joining of Upper and Lower Egypt)



### Government Officials


· Powerful, wealthy, noble families, very high quality of life

 Religious leaders, in charge of temples and rituals, in charge of death and burial






## Scribe


 Recorded information for government and religious leaders
